Mission of the Month – “Mission to Seafarers”.



The Mission to Seafarers is part of the international mission of the Anglican Church, with over 200 centres throughout the world; affectionally known as ‘The Flying Angel Club’ due to the logo.

The aim of the mission is to aid, comfort and support seafarers who are away from home, family, friends and loved ones. A major focus is on the spiritual and mental well-being of seafarers.

The centre at Docklands, Melbourne, also has an historical function (maintaining archives and heritage building); provides a venue for arts and a haven for visiting seafarers (30,000 annually). There are also centres at Geelong, Portland and Hastings.
